hereby orders:

I. that the Defendant i.e. "Telewizja Polska" S.A., with its registered office in Warsaw, shall, within 14 (fourteen) days from the date on which the judgment terminating these proceedings becomes final, issue the following statement:

1. *"Telewizja Polska" S.A. [i.e. Polish Public TV] (KRS No. 0000100679) hereby apologises Ms Lyudmyla Kozlovska, Mr Bartosz Kramek, and the Open Dialogue Foundation domiciled in Warsaw (KRS No. 0000353754) for violating their personal rights such as, in particular, the right to a good name, including reputation and recognition, as well as the right to protect their image in the form of a logo symbolizing the Foundation, through the dissemination of the harmful and false information in numerous articles and video footage posted on www.wiadomosci.tvp.pl, i.e. the website managed by "Telewizja Polska" S.A. The present statement has been released in connection with a lost court case."*

The statement should be typed on an A4 page, in black bold Times New Roman font, and in a font size of not less than 20 points, spacing: 1.5, in the vertical arrangement, against a white background, and in a 3-point-thick black rectangular frame. The present statement has been released in connection with a lost court case”.*

[Polish Public TV joint stock company – in English] with the registered office in Warszawa (KRS (the National Court Register): 0000100679) apologises Ms Ludmyla Kozlovska, Mr Bartosz Kramek and Fundacja Otwarty Dialog [Open Dialogue Foundation - in English] with the registered office in Warszawa (KRS (the National Court Register): 0000353754) for having infringed their personal interests, particularly, the right to respect for their good name, including their reputation and recognition, which had been caused by the dissemination of harmful and false information in the press materials published on the website www.polandin.com. The above statement should be aired within 14 days from the date on which the judgment terminating these proceedings becomes final, on TVP Info as the first new item in "Panorama" at 6:00 p.m. and, in the event that at the time of performance of the obligation this program is no longer broadcast, at 6:00 p.m., by displaying the text of the apology drawn up in black letters against a white background, which text shall be simultaneously read out by a TV anchor, provided that the format of the statement and reading speed ensures its comprehensibility for the average viewer, and the duration of such broadcast must not be less than 30 (thirty) seconds,

10. *"Telewizja Polska" S.A. (KRS: 0000100679) hereby apologises Ms Lyudmyla Kozlovska, Mr Bartosz Kramek, and the Open Dialogue Foundation domiciled in Warsaw (KRS No. 0000353754) for violating their personal rights such as, in particular, the right to a good name, including reputation and recognition, as well as the right to protect their image in the form of a logo symbolizing the Foundation, through the dissemination of the harmful and false information in numerous publications and television footage aired or posted by Telewizja Polską S.A. on www.wiadomosci.tvp.pl, www.tvp.info, <https://vod.tvp.pl/>, www.polandin.com, in the main edition of "Wiadomości" news service on TVP 1 channel, in "Woronicza 17" television program on TVP Info channel, in "Studio Polska" on TVP Info channel, in "Minęła 20" on TVP Info channel, in "Minęła 8" on TVP Info channel, in the special edition of TVP Info on TVP Info channel, in "Serwis Info" on TVP Info channel and on its Twitter profile.

The present statement has been released in connection with a lost court case."
