Dear Sir,

We acknowledge receipt of your correspondence dated 24 July 2017 addressed to the Commission for the Control of INTERPOL's Files. and received on 1 August 2017.

In the context of the admissibility of your request, please provide:

- an original signed letter explaining the purpose of your request,
- a power of attorney (original document) signed by Mr Ierzhan Kadesov authorizing you to access any information about him recorded in INTERPOL's files,
- a copy of his identity document (passport, identity card) with the aim of accurately establishing his identity.
- a precise statement of the factual basis for Mr Ierzhan Kadesov's complaint, including a list and explanation of the alleged violations of INTERPOL's rules

Also, in the context of the study of your request, we should be grateful if you could clearly indicate whether your request to the Commission is:

- a **request for access** to data concerning your client that could be registered in INTERPOL's Files,
or
- a **request for correction/deletion** of data concerning your client that could be registered in INTERPOL's Files.

If your request is a request for correction/deletion of data, please provide the Commission with a short and precise statement of the factual basis for your complaint, including a list and explanation of the possible alleged violations of INTERPOL's rules.

Please send us these documents by postal mail with a valid return postal address to the following address **within two months** from the date of the present letter.
